BABY PUPPY DOG

1ST -APALIE HOLD MY BEER (AI) – MRS M FRASER – *BABY PUPPY IN SHOW*****

Three month old beautiful puppy with excellent type with beautiful head. Already showing strong square muzzle with excellent eye colour and shape. Good bones, in full puppy coat. Teeth changing. Already shows a lot of show attitude. Good strong top line, excellent movement. I would love to see this puppy in the future and wish him all the best. Congratulations.

2nd – APALIE STANDING OVATION AT PADDLEPAWS – PADDLEPAWS KENNELS

Second place baby puppy dog also very nice in type, beautiful head brown puppy with also very good bones. Good top line, well angulated in front and rear. Right now at the moment a little bit V shaped in the front with a little bit pinched elbow. Excellent bone, good tail set and both lovely in movement.

BABY PUPPY BITCH

1ST APALIE LIGHT MY WAY(AI) – MRS M FRASER

Three and a half month old brown puppy with little spot of white on chest in excellent brown solid coat, with beautiful head, typey but feminine expression with excellent pigmentation. Full strong muzzle. Already well developed chest with enormous bones with good depth of chest. Well balanced in front and rear angulation with excellent croup and tail set. In rear movement a little narrow but parallel in front movement. Excellent and beautiful side movement carriage. Good head and tail set.

2nd APALIE MIRACLE OF LIGHT AT SEADALE – MISS B CHAPMAN

Second place puppy also a brown puppy, white spot on chest. Also with very nice lovely head, good muzzle. A little bit less bone, a little bit less in mass. Very balanced with a good length of neck. Balanced in front and rear angulation. A little bit soft in pastern. Right now a little bit high in the rear as normal at this age as they are growing but moved lovely in the side movement and front movement. In the rear movement a little bit narrow and slightly cow hocked. Great coat condition. Both in excellent presentation. Congratulations.

MINOR PUPPY DOG

1ST AMBLEBROOK SIR DIGBY (AI) (*MINOR PUPPY IN SHOW*)

Six month old black puppy, full puppy coat. Showing already a lovely type, beautiful head, excellent expression. Good eye, correct bite. For the size balanced and good bone, massive. A little bit short in upper arm, good top line. Good angulation in the rear, good length of hock. He is a little bit falling down in the croup and carry the tail a little bit higher in the movement, but at this age it is permitted. Lovely typey puppy.

PUPPY DOG

1ST STORYBROOK TEQUILA MOCKINGBIRD – MR R & MRS L CHAPMAN-STEVENSONS (*PUPPY IN SHOW*)

11 month old brown puppy in good size. Very well balanced, in excellent proportion. Lovely head. Right now still a little bit long in ear which will improve. Good eyes, well set apart. Excellent broad square muzzle with excellent stop in good broad skull, slightly arched. Good pigment for brown, good bone, good length of neck flowing into a broad top line. Moves nicely, with balance in the front and rear.

JUNIOR DOG

1ST CH. CLAZZIC MARVELLOUS CREATION – E & C STEWART & S HOLMES

My first is a brown male in excellent size. Still need to mature a little bit in the front chest. Excellent head, good type, good expression, masculine head. He could have little bit more forechest. Excellent length of neck, excellent top line, good length of loin, good croup, balanced in front and rear angulation. Today a little bit out of coat but good balance and head. He will grow up massive.

2ND SHADOZE ON THE MISSISSIPPI (AI) – MR J WOODS

Second male I like a lot. Beautiful in head, excellent type, excellent chest with good bones, beautiful expression, excellent eye colour and shape. A little bit short in upper arm. In the movement today he showed a little bit of falling croup, rolling up a little bit in the top line but balanced and excellent coat condition. Beautiful type. I'm sure he will grow up into a really nice dog.

3RD AMORERUBY WINTER IS COMING – MISS K NIESSEN

Black male with white spot on the chest and toes. Different in type in head. A little bit old school with a little bit too much stop. Would love a little bit darker eye and a little bit more bone. The size is good, coat is in good condition. He was a little bit spooky today. Could be a little bit more angulated in the knee. Also a little bit short in upper arm. Movement was ok. Wish them all the best for the future.

INTERMEDIATE DOG

1ST PROFESOR CANCRIMO (IMP POL) – MR I HARLAND & MR G BARR

My winner in the intermediate class is a brown male. Very very balanced for his age. A little bit short in coat, excellent colour, excellent length of neck. The best forechest I had in this class and standing without being stacked. Absolutely parallel straight front with excellent length of legs, with very good close feet. Lovely head, good expression, typey without being exaggerated. Excellent top line with excellent length of loin, croup angulation. Only detail he could have is a little bit longer tail. In the movement he was catching my eyes keeping excellent head, tail set with covering a lot of ground.

2nd CH. CAPEBASS STOP AT NOTHING – MR L & MRS J LEEDER

My second is also a really nice dog, very very typey. Lovely head. Today he is not fat but eats good food. Excellent coat condition. His movement being a little overweight was a little bit more lazy. Good bone, also standing parallel with excellent bone. Good expression with good eye in shape. Well proportioned head, muzzle and skull. Good length of neck, well developed chest, good top line good length of loin, correct group, balanced in front and rear.

3rd OPALBAY SHAKE UR TAILFEATHER – MRS S BERRY

The third male is a little bit out of undercoat. Excellent size with excellent bones. Right now due to age, a little bit narrow in the front. Ears are a little bit long but good expression in head with correct proportion of muzzle and skull. Excellent length of neck. Excellent topline, good croup, correct length of tail. Balanced.

AUSTRALIAN BRED DOG

1ST CH. NEWFASHION ALL LOVED UP – MS S YEONG

Five year old landseer. Good size. Correct proportion. Lovely head. The eyes are a good colour could be a little bit tighter. Muzzle could be a little be more fillout but in good proportion to the skull. Correct ear set. Medium bone, correct bite, Excellent length of neck, flowing into a good topline. Could have a little bit broader back, balanced in front and rear angulation with good croup. Good length of tail, excellent coat condition. Could have less ticking. Well presented.

BRED BY EXHIBITOR

1ST NEWFASHION DOUBLE O SEVEN (AI) – MR I HARLAND AND MR G BARR

My winner is a beautiful male, excellent condition beautiful head, typey without an exaggeration, very nice eye in excellent shape, position and colour. Excellent ear carriage, well proportion between a very square muzzle in proportion with skull. Excellent forechest standing parallel. Excellent feet. In excellent coat condition. Very balanced in front and rear with broad back that is level and strong, excellent length of croup.

2ND STORYBROOK WHISKY BUSINESS – M&D TALAVANIC/ R& L CHAPMAN-STEVENS

Lovely type, medium bone. In good coat condition. Lovely head, good length of neck, correct in chest. A little bit long in loin, which makes him a little bit long and standing a little bit high in the rear. Correct tail length, balanced in the rear, good balance in the front with good top line. Side movement had a lot of drive keeping tail a little bit high.

OPEN DOG

1ST CH. MAGNEWFICIENT STEP BACK IN TIME (AI) – MR DJ & MRS D BAILEY (CHALLENGE DOG)

My winner in the open class is 6 year old black male in good size, excellent coat condition, well balanced in front and rear with good head, correct proportion between skull and muzzle, good eye, sweet expression, standing parallel on good feet. Excellent pigmentation, good ear set, good length of neck, broad back, correct croup, correct front and rear angulation with good tail set, good length of loin. Moving covering a lot of ground keeping good head. A little bit high in tail set in movement.

2ND CIB A20 CH SUP CH CAPEBASS NOTHING COMPARES TO U – MR L & MRS J LEEDER

My second one was the most massive in the class. Well balanced with good body construction. Enormous bone. I love him standing absolutely parallel without being stacked. Excellent massive bones with good feet. Excellent forechest, well developed chest. Excellent broad top line, good length of loin. Well angulated croup, tail reaching the hocks. Good length of hocks, excellent length of neck. Very typey, of course massive head. A little wrinkling on the muzzle and open eye moving very well in good top line.

3RD SUP CH AMBLEBROOK BUDWEISER – MR A & MRS L BUITENHUIS

My third place dog was the best in movement. Excellent in movement comparing to the other dogs. Would love to see more mass and a little bit more masculine. Nice head, excellent eye colour, good shape well set ears, correct bite. Head in correct proportion with muzzle and skull. Not too lippy, enough forechest, standing a little narrow in the front. Chest deep enough with good top line. Could be a little more broad. Good length of loin, good croup, excellent tail set, standing very balanced in front and rear. Movement was best in class, not an easy decision if he had more mass he would have been my winner.

VETERAN MALE

1ST SUP CH NEWCASTLE WAR PARTY – MRS R NAGLE (*VETERAN IN SHOW*)

The winner of the veteran class was the Landseer male. In excellent coat colour, good white with nearly no ticking. Excellent size and construction, very well balanced, lovely head with sweet expression. Correct proportion between skull and muzzle, good pigmentation for his age, excellent length of neck with excellent forechest. Good shoulder angulation balance with rear with short hock. Standing parallel and excellent feet. The neck is flowing into the very broad large back with excellent croup and excellent tail set. Very, very nice movement keeping an excellent head and tail sets covering a lot of ground with good drive.

2nd CH PLANHAVEN KINGS RANSOM – MRS R PARKIN

My second was an eight years old black male. Beautiful in head with excellent sweet expression. With good dark eye, well set apart which gives him such a sweet expression. I loved especially his square, short muzzle in excellent proportion to the skull. Good ear set, enough length of neck, excellent bone. Good. Massive. Excellent broad back with good length of croup. Excellent tail set balance in front and rear angulation. Today just moved a little bit lazy. Could have a little bit more drive to the movement. Beautiful dog.

MINOR BITCH

1ST AMORERUBY WORTH A LOOK – MISS K NIESEN

Lovely female, growing up nicely. Already shows good attitude, lovely head with sweet feminine expression. Lovely dark eye, almond shaped. Correct proportion between muscle and slightly arched skull. Correct bite, good length of neck. The forechest needs to develop, as well as a little bit more down to the elbow. Already good spring of step. Good top line, good length of loin and correct croup with correct tail set. For her age and size, she already shows good bone and good closed feet. Good coat condition. Moved freely and nicely.

PUPPY BITCH

1ST STORYBROOK LIL ABSINTHE MINDED – MR R & MRS L CHAPMAN-STEVENSON

A very lovely brown puppy in excellent dark brown. Growing up nicely, already shows good attitude. A lovely head, correct pigmentation for a brown dog. Already shows good muzzle with good proportion to the skull. Correct bite, well set ears, that at the moment are a little bit long. Medium substance, standing a little bit narrow. Chest has to develop. Broad neck, good topline, correct loin and good tail set. Moved freely. Good temperament and excellent presentation.

JUNIOR BITCH

1ST SHADOZE LUNAR ECLIPSE (AI) – MR J WOODS (*JUNIOR IN SHOW*)

My winner of the junior class is a beautiful black female. Very balanced. Excellent proportions. Beautiful typey feminine head. Correct proportion of skull and muzzle. Good eyes in position which makes sweet expression. Standing wide, parallel and good feet. Already showing good chest, excellent broad back. Could have a little bit more rear angulation in the knee. Excellent tail set and really nice movement.

2nd CLAZZIC SMORE TO LOVE – MR C & MRS E STEWART

My second is also a very nice bitch. Medium bone. Excellent proportion between skull and muzzle. Could be a little bit more filled out under the eyes. Excellent ear set, excellent pigmentation. Correct bite. Forechest needs to develop. Very balanced in front and rear. Good top line. Good condition. Good croup and tail set. Lovely movement.

3rd AMORERUBY SEAS THE DAY – MISS K NIESSEN & MS L VALE

Third junior bitch, black female in good size. In changing coat. Medium bone. Correct proportion in head. A little bit round and I wish could bit a little bit darker. Well set ears, which at the moment are a little bit long. Good length of neck which is going into a good top line. Good loin. Correct croup. Forechest needs to develop a little more. Correct angulation in the shoulder, a little bit steep in the rear. Could have a little bit more angulation in the knee. Moving freely, nice temperament, well presented.

INTERMEDIATE BITCH

1ST OPALBAY SHAKE EM UP SYDNEY – MRS S BERRY (*RUNNER UP & INTERMEDIATE IN SHOW*)

My Winner in the intermediate class. Outstanding black female in good size. Correct proportions, very nice head with feminine expression, good eye in shape and colour. Strong broad muzzle which is in correct proportion with a slightly arch skull. Correct ear set, massive bone, standing parallel wide. Good length of neck which is going into a strong broad top line. Good length of loin. Good croup. In excellent condition. Moving freely, covering a lot of ground. Keeping a good head and tail set. Friendly temperament with professional presentation.

2nd NEWFASHION CRISSED AS A PICKET – MR I HARLAND & MR G BARR

Black female, very well balanced. In good show condition, nice outline, lovely head with feminine expression. Correct proportion between skull and muzzle. Correct eye with good pigmentation. Standing a little bit narrow. Good bone, good feet and correct length of neck. Very broad and strong top line. Would love to see a little bit more tuck up on the belly line. Balance in front and rear angulation. Lovely temperament. Professional presentation.

3rd NEWFASHION POP IT LIKE ITS HOT – MRS S BROWN & MR I HARLAND

Lovely black female in good size. Strong but feminine. Well balanced, nice overall looking. Very lovely head, dark eye, sweet expression. Correct ear set. Good pigmentation. Correct bite. Standing a little bit narrow with good bone. Correct chest, correct length of neck with a broad back. Good loin, correct croup with good tail set. Lovely female in good coat condition. Correct in the side movements, a little bit narrow in the rear movement but parallel. Needs to be a little bit more stable in the front movement.

STATE BRED BITCH

1ST MAGNEWFICENT TRUE DREAMS (AI) – MS J PEACE & MR M DOHERTY (STATE BRED IN SHOW)

Lovely black female. Good size, feminine, with correct proportions. Lovely head, could be a little bit more filled out under the eyes, but correct proportion between muzzle and slightly arch skull. Good pigmentation. Good bite, good bones. Standing parallel with good forechest and good depth of chest. Good top line, balanced in front and rear angulation. Moved with good covering ground and good drive. Keeping a good head, top line and tail carriage. Well presented.

2nd CH. NEWFLABEL FRENCH BLUE DIAMOND (AI) – MS J WALLACE

Black female medium size. Feminine with lovely head, good expression, good dark eye. Good bones and good length of neck. Would love to have a little bit more leg on her and better rear angulation in the knee. Correct bite. Good tail set. Good coat condition. Moving nicely with good temperament and good presentation.

AUSTRALIAN BRED BITCH

1st CH. NEWFASHION THANKFUNK FOR THAT – MR I HARLAND MR G BARR (AUST BRED IN SHOW)

The winner of this class is a beautiful brown female. In excellent show condition. Full of coat with a beautiful head. Typey but still feminine. Excellent proportions of short, square muzzle. Good fill out under the eye with excellent, slight arched crown. Good bite. For brown excellent pigmentation. Excellent eye in shape, placement and colour. Excellent colour, very broad chest. She is standing herself without being stacked. Parallel wide front with excellent closed feet. Excellent length of neck is flowing into a very broad, strong top line. Good length of loin, excellent croup. Excellent tail set. Proportions are absolutely correct. In her movement she is showing the best of herself. Covering ground with good reach. Excellent head carriage and keeping a strong top line and excellent carried tail set.

2nd MAGNEWFICENT CHIC CHIC BOOM (AI) – MR DJ & MRS D BAILEY

She is a huge, very nice female. Lovely head with correct proportion between skull and muzzle. Good pigmentation, good bone for her size. Excellent length of neck which is flowing very smoothly into the top line. Good shoulder which is balanced with the rear angulation. A broad top line, good length of loin, good croup. A little bit low tail set. Good coat condition. In the side movement,

covering a lot of ground with good reach. Keeping a very good top line. Would love to see a little better tail carriage in movement.

3rd CH. SEADALE GALWAY BAY (AI) – MISS B CHAPMAN

This female caught my eye and attention. She is so lovely. Today she is not in best show condition as she is out of coat, but we can see the nice construction. The beautiful head with the very sweet expression. Correct eye with a slightly arched crown, with well filled out muzzle. For her size, good bone. Standing parallel with good feet, good length of neck and a good top line. A good length of loin, good tail set. Moving fluidly. I am sure that when she is in full coat, she is a very lovely bitch.

BRED BY EXHIBITOR BITCH

1ST CH. BOUVET NEVER SAY NEVER – MRS A KELLY *(BRED BY EXHIBITOR IN SHOW)*

My winner here is a really nice well balanced good sized female. Very feminine, excellent bone, excellent condition. Lovely head, in excellent proportion between skull and muzzle with slightly arched crown. Could have darker eyes. Excellent length of neck with well developed forechest. Broad neck which goes into an extremely strong, broad horizontal backline. In an absolutely correct length of loin and excellent tail sets. Very balanced in front and rear. Excellent coat condition. Very nice temperament. Extremely sound mover, covering a lot of ground a lot of drive and keeping an extremely good head and tail carriage.

2ND CLAZZIC MELTING MOMENT AT CAPEBASS – MR L & MRS J LEEDER

My second bitch is really nice, huge female which needs just a little bit more time to fill out. Very lovely head, good proportion between skull and muzzle with slightly arched crown. Good bite. Correct pigmentation. Needs to develop a little bit more chest. Standing a little bit narrow, but with good bone. Good length of neck which is flowing into the top line which is broad. Correct length of croup. Balanced in the front and rear angulation. In the rear, movement a little bit narrow but parallel. In the front movement, needs to be a little bit more stable. Excellent in the side movement. Very lovely temperament and excellent presentation.

3RD CH STORYBROOK CAUGHT YA PEAKIN – MR R & MRS L CHAPMAN-STEVENSON

Very lovely and very feminine with a nice head, good eye well set and dark. Well proportioned muscle and slightly arched skull. Muzzle is well filled out. Excellent pigmentation. Good correct well set eyes. Good length of neck, medium bone. Could stand a little bit better on her pasterns. Could have a little bit more forechest. Good depth of chest. Balance in front and rear. Little bit high tail set. In the side movement covering good ground. Keeping correct head carriage but carries the tail a little high. She was a little bit out of coat today.

OPEN BITCH

1ST CH. MAGNEWFICENT MOMENTS LIKE THIS (AI) – MR DJ & MRS D BAILEY (BEST IN SHOW) & (OPEN IN SHOW) (CHALLENGE BITCH)

My winner in the open class female is an outstanding white and black Newfoundland, which I love in all the details. She is massive, strong but still keeping femininity. Very, very lovely head, with nice good sweet expression. Good proportion between skull, which is slightly arched with a full muzzle. Good pigmentation, correct bite, well set ears. Good length of neck, which is broad and flowing smoothly into a broad, strong top line. Very balanced in the front and rear angulation. Good bone. Correct length of loin. Excellent tail set and tail carriage. With very clean colour, good markings. Moving with good drive, keeping excellent head and tail carriage with very typical heavy trotter. Representing the breed at her very best

2nd A20 CH GRAND CH C I B NEWFASHION A LITTLE BIT TIPSY AT CLAZZIC

A very, very nice black female. Lovely head correct proportion between skull and muzzle. Medium brown eye. Correct ear set which could be a little bit smaller. Correct bones for her size. Well developed chest. Strong, broad neck which is flowing into a broad back. Excellent condition. Balance in front and rear. Good side movement, covering a lot of ground and keeping good head carriage, correct top line and good tail carriage.

NEUTER BITCH

1ST SUP. CH. NEWFASHION LETS GO GIRL – MISS_K NIESSEN (NEUTER IN SHOW)

She caught my eye as soon as she came into the ring. Beautiful, beautiful female. Massive in good size without any exaggeration. Very feminine, very well balanced. Very nice overall silhouette. Lovely head. Correct proportion between skull and muzzle. Correct bite. Correct pigmentation. Excellent chest in all dimensions. Excellent bone, with very good feet. Correct length of neck which is going into a good strong broad top line. Very balanced in front and rear. In excellent show condition with a friendly temperament and professional presentation

2nd CH NEUT CH CAPEBASS A PROMISE KEPT TK.I – MS S YEONG (RUNNER UP NEUTER IN SHOW)

A lovely female, very feminine. Very well balanced. Would love to see a little bit more mass on her. Lovely head with correct proportion between the skull which is slightly arched and the muzzle. Would love to see a little bit better almond shaped eyes. The ear set is good but carried a little bit flat to the head. Standing very nicely, parallel. For her size and substance, correct bone. Correct feet. Well developed chest. Excellent length of neck, which is flowing into a solid, horizontal broad

top line. Correct underline which is slightly tucked up. Very balanced in front and rear. Good length of line, excellent croup. Very powerful in the movement, keeping good head and tail carriage

3rd CH. NEWFLABEL BLACK DIAMOND (AI) – MS J WALLACE

Also, a lovely strong female. Well balanced, correct proportion. Good head with dark eye. Good expression. Ears are well set, could carry it flatter to the head. She has correct proportion of the skull to the muzzle. The muzzle could be a little bit more filled out. Good pigmentation. Correct bite. Standing correctly on her feet. Well developed chest, good rib. Good length of neck flowing into a broad, extremely sold, large back. Correct length of loin, good croup. Correct tail set. In the movement she showed really good drive. Very friendly temperament and nice presentation.
